

Technical Visit to Lai Chi Kok DSD Transfer Scheme using a TBM

Date: 17 September 2011 (Saturday)

Time: 9:00 am to 12:30 pm (approx)

Transportation & Meeting Point: Attendees should make their own arrangements to travel to the site by MTR to Lai Chi Kok MTR Station (Exit C). A map will be provided for the short walk between the MTR station and the site on confirmation of registration.

Brief project description: Key project features encompass 6 drop shaft intakes arranged on the Lai Chi Kok hillside to intercept storm water runoff and direct water into the 4.9m-dia Branch Tunnel constructed by using slurry tunnel boring machine ("TBM") through mainly bedrock. The Branch Tunnel discharges into the Stilling Basin structure which is constructed below Butterfly Valley Road at the former Wai Man Tsuen. The 4.9m-dia Main Tunnel, also constructed by slurry TBM, comprises an inverted siphon with inlet Shaft M1 and outlet Shaft M2 adjacent to Victoria Harbour.

Attendees should arrive at the site by 9:00 am for a safety induction and project briefing.

PROGRAMME HIGHLIGHTS

- See a in operation in the main tunnel and spillway construction. The TBM operates at the highest pressure of any tunnel construction in Hong Kong to date (4.2 Bar).
- See adit construction in the branch tunnel
