YEAHK Engineering Excellence Award 2014

To encourage young engineers to think creatively, explore new ideas and inspire all those around us, the Hong Kong chapter of Engineers Australia is launching the YEAHK Engineering Excellence Award.

Applicants are required to submit a 1000 word article on any engineering project, research, or engineering futurism and insight on trends in the engineering industry. The article will be judged equally on engineering innovation/creativity, technical excellence and quality of the written presentation.

The winning applicant will be awarded the opportunity to attend the **Engineering Australia Convention 2014** in Melbourne. The package includes a full week pass to the convention, return air ticket and accommodation during the week (more details below). All eligible entries for the competition will be published in the Global Reach international news letter. This is a great way to gain professional exposure and share your insights among international EA members.

Prize

Winner:

- 5 days Convention Pass (24th – 28th November 2014)
 - Access to six distinctive engineering conference
 - 20 workshops, symposia, forums and seminars on professional and personal development
 - Major welcome event to celebrate Convention 2014 at the MCG
 - Breakfast focusing around women in engineering, industry and futurism
 - Over 10 social events across five days
 - Site tours (featuring engineering heritage buildings and locations around Melbourne)

Criteria

Judges will be paying attention to originality and sound development of ideas. Innovative approaches to solve engineering problems will be assessed.

Length: The article must be no more than 1000 words (A4 size paper, minimum font size 11 Arial, top and bottom page margins combine should not be less than 5cm total, left and right margins taken together should not be less than 6cm total). Figures may be included.

Reference (if applicable): Submitted as a separate document (pdf format).

Eligibility: Candidate must be a Young (35 years old or younger) EA member (Graduate Member or above) currently residing in Hong Kong

Submission: Written article (in PDF format) should be submitted to Simon Fan (info@ieausthk.org) on or before 26th September 2014. The winner will be announced on 8th October 2014.
