

Technical Seminar Air Movement for Energy-Efficient Comfort in Conditioned Spaces

Programme Highlights

This seminar will help participants learn about HVAC design strategy that pairs elevated air speeds with traditional air conditioning in order to achieve energy savings. The presentation will describe the additional design benefits from minimizing ductwork, lowering HVAC costs, improving ventilation rates and reducing condensation, as well as explain significant energy savings potential from de-stratifying a large open space. Speaker will also share some applications with ceiling fans to achieve thermal comfort and energy efficient, and introduce contribution to sustainable living programs like LEED and BEAM Plus.

Speaker: Matt Chan

Mr. Matt Chan is currently working as Business Development Manager in Big Ass Fans for East Asia region. He has been working with architects, engineers, listed companies and organizations for projects like WWF, YMCA, Cathay Pacific, Theme park in Hong Kong and Shanghai to increase thermal comfort. Matt delivered presentations on the subject of air movement and energy-efficiency to many professional associations and organizations like the Platinum Hong Kong and AIA Hong Kong Chapter.
