In this technical talk Covey Associates, an Australian-based engineering consultancy, will provide an overview of their experience and expertise in the use of Water Sensitive Urban Design (WSUD) to provide water treatment.

Dr. Christopher Walker is the Environmental Manager at Covey Associates and has significant experience in the design and management (construction and operational phases) of constructed lakes, wetlands, floating wetlands, and bio-retention basins. Dr Walker is highly skilled in storm water quality modelling, using software such as MUSIC (Model for Urban Stormwater Improvement conceptualisation), Water Sensitive Urban Design (WSUD) development and implementation, designing water quality monitoring programs and ensuring site specific environmental objectives are consistently achieved. Dr. Walker is also a recognised world expert on the use of floating wetlands to treat runoff.
