Andrew Young is a mechanical engineer trained in South Australia and worked extensively in engineering field in Australia covering defence, construction, manufacturing and engineering consulting. He was one the first pioneers in university technology transfer in Hong Kong, working at the Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU). He was instrumental in many of the PolyU technologies reaching commercialization.

In recent times at HKSTP, he has been involved with many technology startups and SMEs in diverse fields covering biotechnology, engineering, material science, design technology and seen the SP tech community grow rapidly from 400 to 650 over last few years.

Ir. Patrick Siu CEng MICE MHKIE

Patrick Siu is a civil engineer by training and has over 30 years' professional experience in managing large scale multi-disciplinary infrastructure projects, estate and lease management.

Patrick joined the Hong Kong Industrial Estates Corporation (HKIEC), one of the merger partners of the Hong Kong Science and Technology Parks Corporation (HKSTP) in 1989. He was responsible for the formation of the near 100 ha TKO Industrial Estate (IE) from planning to site formation and the procurement of the respective land grants from the government. He set up the framework for the procurement of consultants and contracts leading to the successful completion of HKSTP Phase 2, and improved the utilization of the IE sites. He is also the driver behind the new strategy and business model and guidelines for the IE2.0 programme that helps to drive for reindustrialization in Hong Kong.

Patrick has recently taken up the position as Chief Operating Officer in HKSTP. He continues to oversee the development of the new IE2.0 and strives to synchronize the FM and Leasing of the SP and the IEs under the new IE2.0 model.


